

# RIONDEL RECYCLING UPDATE

as of July 10, 2020

The new Riondel Recycling Center, located next to the Tip-It garbage bins towards the west end of Fowler St., will be open for use beginning Monday, July 13<sup>th</sup>.

Recycling hours will be the same as the Tip-It bin hours: currently 6:45 am to 10:30 am on Mondays & 9 am to 11 am on Thursdays. There will be an attendant present at the Recycling Center to answer questions, assist with sorting of materials, and offer a pamphlet providing a detailed explanation of recycling options. The Riondel Recycling location is a satellite operation, and is limited to taking in clean and dry paper & cardboard, empty and clean metal & plastic & milk containers, and empty and clean glass containers. All other recyclables, including Styrofoam, can be taken to the Crawford Bay Transfer Station. Users will find that the new recycling program collects materials that we have previously been unable to recycle locally.

We ask for your patience during the initial roll-out of the new system, as both attendants and users become familiar with the system's day-to-day operation. For those who have supported the Kootenay Lake Lions Club collection of refundable recycling, the blue Lions bin is now located between the Tip-It bins and the Recycling Centre.
